

Toyota Ireland Logic for selection criteria

1. Take Toyota plus top 6 best-selling competitors as per September YTD sales (Source: SIMI)
2. Select top selling individual grade variant for each model (source: Jato)
3. Jato assigns a UID (Unique Identifier) to each grade/version
4. Use the UID for each of Toyota plus top 5 best-selling competitors to search for fuel consumption (source: Jato - see Jato Fuel Consumption worksheet)
5. Calculate the average of the competitors (Excel formula =average(range of values for competitors))
6. Calculate the difference between Toyota and the average of competitors
7. Use AA Ireland Fuel Cost value from AA Ireland website to calculate fuel saving over 17,422 kms (CSO average)

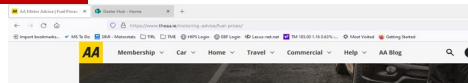

Conclusion:

- Toyota Yaris hybrid uses 243 litres less fuel than the average of the leading competitors
- At €1.86p per litre of fuel, Toyota Yaris saves €455 per year in fuel costs versus the average of the leading competitors
- This saving equates to a 26% reduction in fuel costs compared with the average of the leading competitors

Road traffic volumes

- In 2018, Irish licensed vehicles travelled a total of 47.5 billion kilometres. Each vehicle travelled, on average, 17,422 kilometres in 2018.
- Private cars accounted for 77.6% of the total number of licensed vehicles and 75.7% of the total distance travelled in 2018. On average, each private car travelled 16,990 kilometres in 2018.

COVID-19 Release Information

This publication has been compiled during the COVID-19 crisis. The results contained in the publication reflect some of the economic impacts of the COVID-19 situation.

Road traffic volumes

- Road traffic volumes have been impacted by COVID-19 restrictions. In 2020, Irish licensed vehicles travelled a total of 36.2 billion kilometres, compared with 47.1 billion kilometres in 2019.
- Each vehicle travelled, on average, 6,378 kilometres in 2020, a decrease of 24.6% compared with 2019.
